Mr. RICHARDSON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Commerce

## A BILL

To amend title XIX of the Social Security Act to provide for mandatory coverage of services furnished by nurse practitioners and clinical nurse specialists under State Medicaid plans.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. MEDICAID COVERAGE OF SERVICES FUR-
- 4 NISHED BY CERTIFIED NURSE PRACTITION-
- 5 ERS AND CLINICAL NURSE SPECIALISTS.
- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1905(a)(21) of the Social
- 7 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396d(a)(21)) is amended to read
- 8 as follows:

- 1 "(21) services furnished by a certified nurse 2 practitioner (as defined by the Secretary) or a clinical nurse specialist (as defined in subsection (t)) 3 which the certified nurse practitioner or clinical 5 nurse specialist is legally authorized to perform 6 under State law (or the State regulatory mechanism provided by State law), whether or not the certified 7 8 nurse practitioner or clinical nurse specialist is 9 under the supervision of, or associated with, a physi-10 cian or other health care provider;".
- 11 (b) Definition of Clinical Nurse Specialist.—
- 12 Section 1905 of such Act (42 U.S.C. 1396d) is amended
- 13 by adding at the end the following new subsection:
- 14 "(t) The term 'clinical nurse specialist' means an in-
- 15 dividual who has earned a master's degree in a clinical
- 16 area of nursing from an accredited institution and who
- 17 is a registered nurse licensed to practice nursing in the
- 18 State in which the individual furnishes services.".
- 19 (c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 20 subsections (a) and (b) shall apply to calendar quarters
- 21 beginning on or after January 1, 1998, without regard
- 22 to whether or not final regulations to carry out such
- 23 amendments have been promulgated by such date.
