Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. PROHIBITION OF FEDERAL FUNDING FOR

ELECTION OF OFFICERS AND TRUSTEES OF

INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF TEAM
STERS.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no Federal funds may be obligated or expended to pay the ex-

penses of an election officer appointed by a court to over-
