A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to remove the sunset and numerical limitation on Medicare participation in Medicare+Choice medical savings account (MSA) plans.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Medicare Medical Sav-
5 ings Account (MSA) Expansion Act of 1997”.

1 **SEC. 2. REMOVAL OF SUNSET AND NUMERICAL LIMITATION**
2 **ON PARTICIPATION IN MEDICARE+CHOICE**
3 **MEDICAL SAVINGS ACCOUNT (MSA) PLANS.**

5 U.S.C. 1395w-21(b)(4)), as added by section 4001 of the

7 (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking the first

9 (2) in subparagraph (C), by striking the second
