- 3 SECTION 1. RESTORATION OF TRADITIONAL DAY OF OB-
- 4 SERVANCE OF MEMORIAL DAY.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 6103(a) of title 5, United
- 6 States Code, is amended in the item relating to Memorial
- 7 Day by striking "the last Monday in May." and inserting
- 8 "May 30.".

- 1 (b) DISPLAY OF FLAG.—Section 2(d) of the joint res-
- 2 olution entitled "An Act to codify and emphasize existing
- 3 rules and customs pertaining to the display and use of
- 4 the flag of the United States of America", approved June
- 5 22, 1942 (36 U.S.C. 174(d)), is amended by striking "the
- 6 last Monday in May;" and inserting "May 30;".
- 7 (c) Proclamation.—The President is authorized
- 8 and requested to issue a proclamation calling upon the
- 9 people of the United States to observe Memorial Day as
- 10 a day for prayer and ceremonies that show respect for
- 11 American veterans of wars and other military conflicts.
