- 4 SEC. 2. LANDS HELD IN TRUST FOR VARIOUS TRIBES OF
- 5 CALIFORNIA INDIANS.
- 6 (a) In General.—Subject to valid existing rights,
- 7 all right, title, and interest of the United States in and
- 8 to the lands, including improvements and appurtenances,
- 9 described in a paragraph of subsection (b) in connection
- 10 with the respective tribe, band, or group of Indians named
- 11 in such paragraph are hereby declared to be held in trust
- 12 by the United States for the benefit of such tribe, band,
- 13 or group. Real property taken into trust pursuant to this
- 14 subsection shall not be considered to have been taken into
- 15 trust for gaming (as that term is used in the Indian Gam-
- 16 ing Regulatory Act (25 U.S.C. 2701 et seq.)).

- 3 (b) Notice of Cancellation of Grazing Pref-
- 4 ERENCES.—Grazing preferences on lands described in sec-
- 5 tion 2 shall terminate 2 years after the date of the enact-
- 6 ment of this Act.
- 7 (c) Laws Governing Lands To Be Held In
- 8 Trust.—Any lands which are to be held in trust for the
- 9 benefit of any tribe, band, or group of Indians pursuant
- 10 to this Act shall be added to the existing reservation of
- 11 the tribe, band, or group, and the official boundaries of
- 12 the reservation shall be modified accordingly. These lands
- 13 shall be subject to the laws of the United States relating
- 14 to Indian land in the same manner and to the same extent
- 15 as other lands held in trust for such tribe, band, or group
- 16 on the day before the date of enactment of this Act.
