A BILL

For the relief of Sylvester Flis.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF CERTAIN NATURALIZATION RE-**
4 **QUIREMENTS FOR SYLVESTER FLIS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the inability of
6 Sylvester Flis to meet the requirements of section 316 of
7 the Immigration and Naturalization Act that relate to res-
8 idence and physical presence in the United States, if oth-
9 erwise qualified he shall be considered eligible for natu-
10 ralization and, upon filing an application for naturaliza-
11 tion and being administered the oath of allegiance pursu-

1 ant to section 337 of such Act, shall be naturalized as
2 a citizen of the United States.

3 (b) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
4 FEES.—Subsection (a) shall apply only if the application
5 for naturalization is filed with appropriate fees within 2
6 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.
