A BILL

For the relief of Clarence P. Stewart.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RELIEF OF CLARENCE P. STEWART.**

4 Notwithstanding the failure of Clarence P. Stewart
5 of Broadway, North Carolina, to file a timely appeal of
6 his wrongful dismissal, during a reduction in force, from
7 the Department of Agriculture as a State Executive Direc-
8 tor for the former Agricultural Stabilization and Con-
9 servation Service of the Department, the Secretary of Ag-
10 riculture shall cause Clarence P. Stewart to be afforded
11 relief that is fully commensurate with the relief afforded
12 the similarly-dismissed appellants in the case before the
