A BILL

To require air carriers to charge a reduced fare for air transportation to and from certain clinical health trials.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. GENERAL REQUIREMENT.
- 4 An air carrier may not charge a person participating
- 5 in a clinical health trial sponsored by the National Insti-
- 6 tutes of Health or any other Federal agency or a univer-
- 7 sity or college or approved by an institutional review board
- 8 a fare for air transportation to enable such person to trav-
- 9 el to and from such trial that is greater than the advance
- 10 purchase fare for such air transportation.

- 2 In this Act, the following definitions apply:
- (1) ADVANCED PURCHASE FARE.—The term

 "advanced purchase fare" as used with respect to

 air transportation provided by an air carrier means

 the lowest fare the air carrier charges for the air

 transportation if the ticket for the air transportation

 is purchased in advance and includes an overnight

 stay.
 - (2) AIR CARRIER.—The term "air carrier" has the meaning such term has under section 40102(a) of title 49, United States Code.
- 13 (3) AIR TRANSPORTATION.—The term "air 14 transportation" has the meaning such term has 15 under such section.
