**AN ACT**

To redesignate the building of the United States Postal Service located at 2419 West Monroe Street, in Chicago, Illinois, as the “Nancy B. Jefferson Post Office Building”.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION.**

4       The building of the United States Postal Service lo-  
5       cated at 2419 West Monroe Street, in Chicago, Illinois,  
6       and known as the Midwest Post Office Building, shall be  
7       known and designated as the “Nancy B. Jefferson Post  
8       Office Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the building  
4 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference  
5 to the “Nancy B. Jefferson Post Office Building”.
