- 3 SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF NEW MEXICO COMMERCIAL
- 4 ZONE.
- 5 (a) COMMERCIAL ZONE DEFINED.—In this Act, the
- 6 term "commercial zone" means a zone containing lands
- 7 adjacent to, and commercially a part of, 1 or more munici-
- 8 palities with respect to which the exception described in

- 1 section 13506(b)(1) of title 49, United States Code, applies.
- 3 (b) Designation of Zone.—
- 4 (1) IN GENERAL.—The area described in para-5 graph (2) is designated as a commercial zone, to be 6 known as the "New Mexico Commercial Zone".
- 7 (2) Description of Area.—The area de-8 scribed in this paragraph is the area that is com-9 prised of Dona Ana County and Luna County in 10 New Mexico.
- 11 (c) SAVINGS PROVISION.—Nothing in this Act shall 12 affect any action commenced or pending before the Sec-13 retary of Transportation or Surface Transportation Board
