- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Consumer Health Free
- 5 Speech Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. DEFINITION.
- 7 Section 201(g)(1) of the Federal Food, Drug, and
- 8 Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 321(g)(1)) is amended in clause
- 9 (B) by inserting "(other than food)" after "articles".

1 SEC. 3. ADULTERATED FOOD.

- 2 Section 402(f)(1) of the Federal Food, Drug, and
- 3 Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 342(f)(1)) is amended in sub-
- 4 paragraphs (A) and (B) by striking "significant or unrea-
- 5 sonable" and inserting "significant and unreasonable".

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
