Mr. LUTHER (for himself, Mr. KASICH, Mr. DELLUMS, and Mr. FOLEY) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on National Security

A BILL

To limit production of the B–2 bomber.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “B–2 Bomber Produc-
5 tion Limitation Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON NUMBER OF B-2 BOMBER AIR-**
7 **CRAFT.**

8 (a) **LIMITATION.**—The Secretary of the Air Force
9 may not contract for any B–2 bomber aircraft beyond the
10 21 aircraft already delivered to the Air Force or under
11 contract.

1 (b) FUNDING LIMITATION.—No funds appropriated
2 for the Air Force for research, development, test, and eval-
3 uation or for procurement of aircraft may be obligated for
4 B-2 bomber aircraft other than for costs associated
5 with—

6 (1) completing production of the 21 aircraft al-
7 ready delivered to the Air Force or under contract;

8 (2) modifications to such aircraft as authorized
9 by law; and

10 (3) closure of the production line.
