- 1 286a-8(c)) is amended in the first sentence by striking
- 2 "\$72,000,000" and all that follows and inserting the fol-
- 3 lowing: "\$86,000,000 for fiscal year 1998, \$100,000,000
- 4 for fiscal year 1999, \$115,000,000 for fiscal year 2000,
- 5 and \$130,000,000 for fiscal year 2001.".

- 7 SEARCH.—Section 902 of the Public Health Service Act
- 8 (42 U.S.C. 299a) is amended by adding at the end the

- "(1) conduct and support research on the out-
