3 **SECTION 1. EXPANSION OF AUTHORIZED NUMBER OF MED-**
4 **ICAID COUNTY ORGANIZED HEALTH INSUR-**
5 **ING ORGANIZATIONS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 9517(c)(3) of the Consoli-
7 dated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1985 (42

1 U.S.C. 1396b note), as added by section 4734 of the Om-
2 nibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1990, is amended—

3 (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking “up to 3”
4 and inserting “up to 7”, and

5 (2) in subparagraph (C), by striking “10 per-
6 cent” and inserting “20 percent”.

7 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
8 subsection (a) shall be effective as if included in the enact-
9 ment of the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1990.

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
