## A BILL

- To amend title 38, United States Code, to permit retired members of the Armed Forces who have service-connected disabilities to receive compensation from the Department of Veterans Affairs concurrently with retired pay, without deduction from either.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
  - 3 That section 5304(a)(1) of title 38, United States Code,
  - 4 is amended by adding at the end thereof the following:
  - 5 "Notwithstanding the preceding sentence, emergency offi-
  - 6 cers', regular, or reserve retirement pay may be paid to

- 1 any veteran concurrently with compensation for any serv-
- 2 ice-connected disability, without deduction from either the
- 3 retirement pay or the compensation; however, nothing in
- 4 this sentence shall permit payment of retirement pay and
- 5 of compensation based upon the same disability.".
