- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Legislative Branch
- 5 Drug Testing Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. RANDOM DRUG TESTING IN LEGISLATIVE BRANCH.
- 7 Each House of Congress, and each other entity with-
- 8 in the legislative branch of the Federal Government, shall

- 1 require random drug testing of Members, officers, and em-
- 2 ployees within their respective bodies.
