A BILL

To amend the Trademark Act of 1946 with respect to the dilution of famous marks.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That section 43(c)(3) of the Act entitled "An Act to pro-
- 4 vide for the registration and protection of trade-marks
- 5 used in commerce, to carry out the provisions of certain
- 6 international conventions, and for other purposes." (com-
- $7\,$ monly referred to as the "Trademark Act of 1946") is
- 8 amended by adding at the end the following: "Such owner-
- 9 ship shall be a complete bar to an action against that per-
- 10 son under paragraph (1) if the action is commenced more

- 1 than 365 days after the date of registration or 365 days
- 2 after the person began to use the mark or trade name

3 in commerce, whichever is later.".
