- 3 That the Controlled Substances Act and the Controlled
- 4 Substances Import and Export Act apply according to
- 5 their terms, notwithstanding any State law that purport-
- 6 edly authorizes the use or distribution, by an individual

- 1 or a group, of marijuana or any controlled substance, for
- 2 medicinal or any other purpose.
