A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on organic luminescent pigments, dyes and fibers for security applications, and 4-Hexylresorcinol.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DUTY.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new headings:

“	9902.32.04	Organic luminescent pigments, dyes and fibers for security applications (provided for in subheading 3204.90.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2001	
	9902.29.07	4-Hexylresorcinol (CAS No. 136-77-6) (provided for in subheading 2907.29.90)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2001	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
 2 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to goods entered,
 3 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
 4 the date that is 15 days after the date of the enactment
 5 of this Act.
