## A BILL

To prohibit movies in which a tobacco company has paid to have its tobacco product featured.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. TOBACCO COMPANIES AND MOVIES.
- 4 No person who is engaged in the production of movies
- 5 for commercial viewing may have any arrangement with
- 6 a tobacco company under which such person is paid to
- 7 have a tobacco product featured in the movie. No movie
- 8 which is subject to such an arrangement may be distrib-
- 9 uted in interstate commerce.
