Mr. LUTHER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Commerce

A BILL

To prohibit movies in which a tobacco company has paid to have its tobacco product featured.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TOBACCO COMPANIES AND MOVIES.**

4 No person who is engaged in the production of movies
5 for commercial viewing may have any arrangement with
6 a tobacco company under which such person is paid to
7 have a tobacco product featured in the movie. No movie
8 which is subject to such an arrangement may be distrib-
9 uted in interstate commerce.
