A BILL

To provide for the installation of enhanced vision technologies to replace and enhance conventional lighting systems with respect to airport improvement projects.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Airport Safety Act".
- 5 SEC. 2. REGULATIONS REQUIRING INSTALLATION OF EN-
- 6 HANCED VISUAL TECHNOLOGIES AT AIR-
- 7 PORTS.
- 8 Not later than 365 days after the date of the enact-
- 9 ment of this Act, the Secretary of Transportation shall
