A BILL

To authorize the Washington Interdependence Council to establish a memorial to Mr. Benjamin Banneker in the District of Columbia.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. MEMORIAL TO MR. BENJAMIN BANNEKER IN
- 4 THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA.
- 5 (a) Memorial Authorized.—The Washington
- 6 Interdependence Council of the District of Columbia is au-
- 7 thorized to establish a memorial in the District of Colum-
- 8 bia to honor and commemorate the accomplishments of
- 9 Mr. Benjamin Banneker.

- 1 (b) Compliance With Standards For Commemo-
- 2 RATIVE WORKS.—The establishment of the memorial shall
- 3 be in accordance with the Commemorative Works Act (40
- 4 U.S.C. 1001 et seq.).
- 5 (c) Payment of Expenses.—The Washington
- 6 Interdependence Council shall be solely responsible for ac-
- 7 ceptance of contributions for, and payment of the expenses
- 8 of, the establishment of the memorial. No Federal funds
- 9 may be used to pay any expense of the establishment of
- 10 the memorial.
- 11 (d) Deposit of Excess Funds.—If, upon payment
- 12 of all expenses of the establishment of the memorial (in-
- 13 cluding the maintenance and preservation amount re-
- 14 quired under section 8(b) of the Commemorative Works
- 15 Act (40 U.S.C. 1008(b))), or upon expiration of the au-
- 16 thority for the memorial under section 10(b) of such Act
- 17 (40 U.S.C. 1010(b)), there remains a balance of funds re-
- 18 ceived for the establishment of the memorial, the Washing-
- 19 ton Interdependence Council shall transmit the amount of
- 20 the balance to the Secretary of the Treasury for deposit
- 21 in the account provided for in section 8(b)(1) of such Act
- 22 (40 U.S.C. 1008(b)(1)).
