1	SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON AUTHORITY TO IMPOSE EN-
2	TRANCE FEES FOR CITY POINT UNIT OF PE-
3	TERSBURG NATIONAL BATTLEFIELD.
4	The Act entitled "An Act to establish a national mili-
5	tary park at the battle fields of the siege of Petersburg,
6	Virginia", approved July 3, 1926 (16 U.S.C. 423 et seq.),
7	is amended by adding at the end the following:
8	"Sec. 11. No fee may be imposed by the Department
9	of the Interior for entrance to the City Point Unit of Pe-
10	tersburg National Battlefield, located in the City of Hope-
11	well, Virginia, unless—
12	"(1) the Secretary of the Interior has reim-
13	bursed the City for obligations and expenditures in-
14	curred by the City for rehabilitation of National
15	Park Service property located in the Unit adjacent
16	to the James River; or
17	"(2) the fee does not apply to entrance by a
18	resident of the City.".
