A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to extend certain procedural and appeal rights to employees of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “FBI Fairness to Ap-
5 peal Improvement Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF RIGHTS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 7511(b)(8) of title 5,
8 United States Code, is amended by striking “the Federal
9 Bureau of Investigation,”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 this section shall apply with respect to adverse personnel
3 actions taking effect after the end of the 45-day period
4 beginning on the date of enactment of this Act.
