A BILL

To ban the importation of large capacity ammunition feeding devices, and to extend the ban on transferring such devices to those that were manufactured before the ban became law.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BAN ON IMPORTING LARGE CAPACITY AMMU-
4 NITION FEEDING DEVICES.**

5 Section 922(w) of title 18, United States Code, is
6 amended—

4 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking "(2) Para-
5 graph (1)" and inserting "(B) Subparagraph (A)";

6 (3) by inserting before paragraph (3) the fol-
7 lowing:

8 “(2) It shall be unlawful for any person to import
9 a large capacity ammunition feeding device.”; and

10 (4) in paragraph (4)—

11 (A) by striking “(1)” each place it appears
12 and inserting “(1)(A)”; and

13 (B) by striking "(2)" and inserting
14 "(1)(B)".

15 SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF BAN ON TRANSFERRING LARGE CA-
16 PACITY AMMUNITION FEEDING DEVICES TO
17 THOSE THAT WERE MANUFACTURED BEFORE
18 THE BAN BECAME LAW.

19 (a) ELIMINATION OF EXEMPTION FOR TRANSFER OF
20 DEVICES LAWFULLY POSSESSED BEFORE ENACTMENT
21 OF THE BAN.—Section 922(w)(1)(B) of title 18, United
22 States Code, as so redesignated by section 1 of this Act,
23 is amended by striking “or transfer”.

(b) EXPANDED DEFINITION.—Section 921(a)(31)(A) of such title is amended by striking “manufactured after

- 1 the date of enactment of the Violent Crime Control and
- 2 Law Enforcement Act of 1994”.
