## A BILL

To provide for the liquidation or reliquidation of certain customs entries of nuclear fuel assemblies.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. NUCLEAR FUEL ASSEMBLIES.
- 4 Notwithstanding section 514 of the Tariff Act of
- 5 1930 or any other provision of law, upon proper request
- 6 filed with the Customs Service before the 90th day after
- 7 the date of enactment of this Act, the customs entries list-
- 8 ed in section 2 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as if,
- 9 at the time such entries were made, the following addi-

- 1 tional U.S. note to chapter 84 of the Harmonized Tariff
- 2 Schedule of the United States was in effect:
- 3 "3. Subheading 8401.30.00 applies only to fuel
- 4 rods which are collected into bundles to form fuel as-
- 5 semblies. Enriched uranium compound shipped
- 6 abroad and converted into sintered, enriched ura-
- 7 nium dioxide pellets and then inserted into zir-
- 8 conium alloy tubing which is sealed by the means of
- 9 plugs which are welded into either end are to be
- 10 classified as follows:
- 11 "(a) The uranium pellets are to be classi-
- fied under subheading 2844.20.00 as uranium
- oxide.
- 14 "(b) The zirconium tubing is to be classi-
- fied as an article of base metal under sub-
- heading 8109.90.00.".

#### 17 SEC. 2. APPLICATION.

- 18 Section 1 shall apply to each of the following entries,
- 19 and the Secretary of the Treasury shall refund the amount
- 20 by which the duty previously posted or paid on such entry
- 21 exceeds the amount of duty that would have been paid on
- 22 such entry if the provisions of section 1 were in effect on
- 23 the date of such entry:
