A BILL

To amend title 39, United States Code, to exempt veterans' organizations from regulations prohibiting the solicitation of contributions on postal property.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That section 403 of title 39, United States Code, is
- 4 amended by adding at the end the following:
- 5 "(d)(1) For the purpose of this subsection—
- 6 "(A) the term 'veterans' organization' means an
- 7 organization described in section 501(c)(19) of the
- 8 Internal Revenue Code of 1986; and

1	"(B) the term 'postal property' means any real
2	property under the charge or control of the Postal
3	Service, including any real property leased by or for
4	the Postal Service.
5	"(2) The Postal Service shall take appropriate meas-
6	ures to ensure that nothing in its regulations shall prevent
7	a veterans' organization from soliciting contributions on
8	postal property, so long as those activities do not impede
9	or disturb—
10	"(A) postal employees in the performance of
11	their duties; or
12	"(B) the general public in transacting business
13	or obtaining services provided on such property.".
