- fore "Laws, regulations, and orders"; and
- 8 (2) by adding at the end the following new subsection:

- 1 "(b) Exception for Speed Limits.—Notwith-
- 2 standing subsection (a), State and local governments may
- 3 adopt or continue in force lower speed limits for trains
