A BILL

To amend the Davis-Bacon Act to provide that a contractor under that Act who has repeated violations of the Act shall have its contract with the United States canceled.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REPEATED VIOLATIONS.
- 4 Section 3 of the Act of March 3, 1931 (40 U.S.C.
- 5 276a-2) (known as the Davis-Bacon Act) is amended by
- 6 adding at the end the following:
- 7 "(c) If the Secretary determines that a contractor
- 8 under a contract with the United States has established
- 9 a pattern of violations of this Act the Secretary shall can-

- 1 cel such contract and establish that such contractor is in-
- 2 eligible to receive a contract with the United States for
- 3 a 10 year period unless the contractor is able to show the
- 4 Secretary that such violations were not intentional but

5 were the result of simple and unsystematic error.
