- 3 SECTION 1. DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION.
- 4 (a) General Rule.—Section 552(a) of title 5,
- 5 United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the
- 6 following:
- 7 "(7) The names and addresses of employees in pay-
- 8 roll records established under a contract which is subject
- 9 to the Act of March 3, 1931 (40 U.S.C. 276a–2) (known

- 1 as the Davis-Bacon Act) shall be made available, notwith-
- 2 standing subsection (b)(6), for inspection in connection
- 3 with an audit to determine compliance with such Act.".
- 4 (b) Construction.—Section 552a of title 5, United
- 5 States Code, shall not be construed to prevent or prohibit
- 6 the disclosure required by section 552(a)(7) of title 5,
- 7 United States Code, as added by the amendment made
- 8 by section 1.
