A BILL

To require the disclosure under freedom of information provisions of Federal law of certain payroll information under contracts subject to the Davis-Bacon Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION.**

4 (a) GENERAL RULE.—Section 552(a) of title 5,
5 United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the
6 following:

7 “(7) The names and addresses of employees in pay-
8 roll records established under a contract which is subject
9 to the Act of March 3, 1931 (40 U.S.C. 276a–2) (known

1 as the Davis-Bacon Act) shall be made available, notwith-
2 standing subsection (b)(6), for inspection in connection
3 with an audit to determine compliance with such Act.”.

4 (b) CONSTRUCTION.—Section 552a of title 5, United
5 States Code, shall not be construed to prevent or prohibit
6 the disclosure required by section 552(a)(7) of title 5,
7 United States Code, as added by the amendment made
8 by section 1.
