# A BILL

To grant a Federal charter to the American GI Forum of the United States.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. RECOGNITION AND GRANT OF FEDERAL CHAR-
- 4 TER.
- 5 The American GI Forum of the United States, a non-
- 6 profit corporation organized under the laws of the State
- 7 of New Mexico, is recognized as such and granted a Fed-
- 8 eral charter.

#### 1 SEC. 2. POWERS.

- 2 The American GI Forum of the United States (in this
- 3 Act referred to as the "corporation" shall have only those
- 4 powers granted to it through its bylaws and articles of
- 5 incorporation filed in the State of New Mexico and subject
- 6 to the laws of the State of New Mexico.

#### 7 SEC. 3. PURPOSES.

- 8 The purposes of the corporation are those provided
- 9 in its bylaws and articles of incorporation and shall include
- 10 the following:
- 11 (1) To secure the blessing of American democ-
- 12 racy at every level of local, State, and national life
- for all United States citizens.
- 14 (2) To uphold and defend the Constitution and
- the United States flag.
- 16 (3) To foster and perpetuate the principles of
- 17 American democracy based on religious and political
- freedom for the individual and equal opportunity for
- 19 all.
- 20 (4) To foster and enlarge equal educational op-
- 21 portunities, equal economic opportunities, equal jus-
- tice under the law, and equal political opportunities
- for all United States citizens, regardless of race,
- color, religion, sex, or national origin.
- 25 (5) To encourage greater participation of the
- 26 ethnic minority represented by the corporation in the

- 1 policy-making and administrative activities of all de-
- 2 partments, agencies, and other governmental units
- of local and State governments and the Federal Gov-
- 4 ernment.
- 5 (6) To combat all practices of a prejudicial or
- 6 discriminatory nature in local, State, or national life
- 7 which curtail, hinder, or deny to any United States
- 8 citizen an equal opportunity to develop full potential
- 9 as an individual.
- 10 (7) To foster and promote the broader knowl-
- edge and appreciation by all United States citizens
- of their cultural heritage and language.

#### 13 SEC. 4. SERVICE OF PROCESS.

- With respect to service of process, the corporation
- 15 shall comply with the laws of the State of New Mexico
- 16 and those States in which it carries on its activities in
- 17 furtherance of its corporate purposes.

#### 18 SEC. 5. MEMBERSHIP.

- Except as provided in section 8(g), eligibility for
- 20 membership in the corporation and the rights and privi-
- 21 leges of members shall be as provided in the bylaws and
- 22 articles of incorporation of the corporation.

#### 23 SEC. 6. BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

- Except as provided in section 8(g), the composition
- 25 of the board of directors of the corporation and the re-

- 1 sponsibilities of the board shall be as provided in the by-
- 2 laws and articles of incorporation of the corporation and
- 3 in conformity with the laws of the State of New Mexico.

#### 4 SEC. 7. OFFICERS.

- 5 Except as provided in section 8(g), the positions of
- 6 officers of the corporation and the election of members
- 7 to such positions shall be as provided in the bylaws and
- 8 articles of incorporation of the corporation and in con-
- 9 formity with the laws of the State of New Mexico.

#### 10 SEC. 8. RESTRICTIONS.

- 11 (a) Income and Compensation.—No part of the in-
- 12 come or assets of the corporation may inure to the benefit
- 13 of any member, officer, or director of the corporation or
- 14 be distributed to any such individual during the life of this
- 15 charter. Nothing in this subsection may be construed to
- 16 prevent the payment of reasonable compensation to the
- 17 officers and employees of the corporation or reimburse-
- 18 ment for actual and necessary expenses in amounts ap-
- 19 proved by the board of directors.
- 20 (b) Loans.—The corporation may not make any loan
- 21 to any member, officer, director, or employee of the cor-
- 22 poration.
- 23 (c) Issuance of Stock and Payment of Divi-
- 24 DENDS.—The corporation may not issue any shares of
- 25 stock or declare or pay any dividends.

- 1 (d) Disclaimer of Congressional or Federal
- 2 Approval.—The corporation may not claim the approval
- 3 of Congress or the authorization of the Federal Govern-
- 4 ment for any of its activities by virtue of this Act.
- 5 (e) Corporate Status.—The corporation shall
- 6 maintain its status as a corporation organized and incor-
- 7 porated under the laws of the State of New Mexico.
- 8 (f) Corporate Function.—The corporation shall
- 9 function as an educational, patriotic, civic, historical, and
- 10 research organization under the laws of the State of New
- 11 Mexico.
- 12 (g) Nondiscrimination.—In establishing the condi-
- 13 tions of membership in the corporation and in determining
- 14 the requirements for serving on the board of directors or
- 15 as an officer of the corporation, the corporation may not
- 16 discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, dis-
- 17 ability, age, or national origin.
- 18 SEC. 9. LIABILITY.
- The corporation shall be liable for the acts of its offi-
- 20 cers, directors, employees, and agents whenever such indi-
- 21 viduals act within the scope of their authority.
- 22 SEC. 10. MAINTENANCE AND INSPECTION OF BOOKS AND
- 23 RECORDS.
- 24 (a) Books and Records of Account.—The cor-
- 25 poration shall keep correct and complete books and

- 1 records of account and minutes of any proceeding of the
- 2 corporation involving any of its members, the board of di-
- 3 rectors, or any committee having authority under the
- 4 board of directors.
- 5 (b) Names and Addresses of Members.—The
- 6 corporation shall keep at its principal office a record of
- 7 the names and addresses of all members having the right
- 8 to vote in any proceeding of the corporation.
- 9 (c) Right To Inspect Books and Records.—All
- 10 books and records of the corporation may be inspected by
- 11 any member having the right to vote in any proceeding
- 12 of the corporation, or by any agent or attorney of such
- 13 member, for any proper purpose at any reasonable time.
- 14 (d) Application of State Law.—This section may
- 15 not be construed to contravene any applicable State law.
- 16 SEC. 11. AUDIT OF FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS.
- 17 The first section of the Act entitled "An Act to pro-
- 18 vide for audit of accounts of private corporations estab-
- 19 lished under Federal law", approved August 30, 1964 (36
- 20 U.S.C. 1101), is amended by adding at the end the follow-
- 21 ing:
- 22 "(80) American GI Forum of the United
- 23 States.".

#### 1 SEC. 12. ANNUAL REPORT.

- 2 The corporation shall annually submit to Congress a
- 3 report concerning the activities of the corporation during
- 4 the preceding fiscal year. The annual report shall be sub-
- 5 mitted on the same date as the report of the audit required
- 6 by reason of the amendment made in section 11. The an-
- 7 nual report shall not be printed as a public document.
- 8 SEC. 13. RESERVATION OF RIGHT TO ALTER, AMEND, OR
- 9 **REPEAL CHARTER.**
- The right to alter, amend, or repeal this Act is ex-
- 11 pressly reserved to Congress.
- 12 SEC. 14. TAX-EXEMPT STATUS REQUIRED AS CONDITION OF
- 13 CHARTER.
- 14 If the corporation fails to maintain its status as a
- 15 corporation exempt from taxation as provided in the Inter-
- 16 nal Revenue Code of 1986 the charter granted in this Act
- 17 shall terminate.
- 18 SEC. 15. TERMINATION.
- 19 The charter granted in this Act shall expire if the
- 20 corporation fails to comply with any of the provisions of
- 21 this Act.
- 22 SEC. 16. DEFINITION OF STATE.
- For purposes of this Act, the term "State" includes
- 24 the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto
- 25 Rico, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Is-

- 1 lands, and the territories and possessions of the United
- 2 States.
