3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Congressional Truth
5 and Accountability Act of 1998”.

1 **SEC. 2. IMMUNITY.**

2 Section 6005(b)(2) of title 18, United States Code,
3 is amended by striking out “two-thirds” and inserting “a
4 majority”.
