Mr. GILMAN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to construct and operate a visitor center for the Upper Delaware Scenic and Recreational River on land owned by the State of New York.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Upper Delaware Scenic
- 5 and Recreational River Mongaup Visitor Center Act of
- 6 1998".
- 7 SEC. 2. FINDINGS.
- 8 The Congress finds the following:

- 1 (1) The Secretary of the Interior approved a
 2 management plan for the Upper Delaware Scenic
 3 and Recreational River, as required by section 704
 4 of Public Law 95–625 (16 U.S.C. 1274 note), on
 5 September 29, 1987.
 - (2) The river management plan called for the development of a primary visitor contact facility located at the southern end of the river corridor.
 - (3) The river management plan determined that the visitor center would be built and operated by the National Park Service.
 - (4) The Act which designated the Upper Delaware Scenic and Recreational River and the approved river management plan limits the Secretary of the Interior's authority to acquire land within the boundary of the river corridor.
 - (5) The State of New York authorized on June 21, 1993, a 99-year lease between the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation and the National Park Service for the construction and operation of a visitor center by the Federal Government on State-owned land in the Town of Deerpark, Orange County, New York, in the vicinity of Mongaup, which is the preferred site for the visitor center.

1	SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF VISITOR CENTER FOR UPPER
2	DELAWARE SCENIC AND RECREATIONAL
3	RIVER.
4	For the purpose of constructing and operating a visi-
5	tor center for the Upper Delaware Scenic and Recreational
6	River and subject to the availability of appropriations, the
7	Secretary of the Interior may—
8	(1) enter into a lease with the State of New
9	York, for a term of 99 years, for State-owned land
10	within the boundaries of the Upper Delaware Scenic
11	and Recreational River located at an area known as
12	Mongaup near the confluence of the Mongaup and
13	Upper Delaware Rivers in the State of New York;
14	and
15	(2) construct and operate such a visitor center
16	on land leased under paragraph (2).
