- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Wisconsin Federal
- 5 Judgeship Act of 1998".
- 6 SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL FEDERAL DISTRICT JUDGE FOR THE
- 7 EASTERN DISTRICT OF WISCONSIN.
- 8 (a) In General.—The President shall appoint, by
- 9 and with the advice and consent of the Senate, 1 addi-
- 10 tional district judge for the eastern district of Wisconsin.

1	(b) Tables.—In order that the table contained in
2	section 133(a) of title 28, United States Code, reflects the
3	change in the total number of permanent district judge-
4	ships authorized under subsection (a), such table is
5	amended by amending the item relating to Wisconsin to
6	read as follows:
	"Wisconsin: 5 "Eastern 5 "Western 2".

7 (c) HOLDING OF COURT.—The chief judge of the

8 eastern district of Wisconsin shall designate 1 judge who

9 shall hold court for such district in Green Bay, Wisconsin.
