# A BILL

For the relief of Akal Security, Incorporated.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PAYMENT FOR SERVICES PERFORMED BUT
- 4 NOT PAID.
- 5 Notwithstanding section 2465 of title 10, United
- 6 States Code, the Secretary of the Treasury shall pay, out
- 7 of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,
- 8 to Akal Security, Incorporated, a New Mexico corporation
- 9 incorporated in New Mexico, \$10,208.74 for security
- 10 guard services rendered in 1991 to the United States
- 11 Army Reserve Personnel Center located at 9700 Page
- 12 Boulevard in St. Louis, Missouri.

#### 1 SEC. 2. EXTINGUISHMENT OF LIABILITY.

- 2 Notwithstanding section 2465 of title 10, United
- 3 States Code, any liability of Akal Security, Incorporated,
- 4 to the United States for repayment of \$57,771.29 for the
- 5 services described in section 1 is hereby extinguished.

## 6 SEC. 3. FULL SATISFACTION.

- 7 The relief under sections 1 and 2 shall, when accept-
- 8 ed by or on behalf of Akal Security, Incorporated, be in
- 9 full satisfaction of all claims of or on behalf of Akal Secu-
- 10 rity, Incorporated, against the United States or against
- 11 any officer, employee, or agent of the United States acting
- 12 within the scope of employment or agency, for payment
- 13 for the services described in section 1.

#### 14 SEC. 4. LIMITATION ON ATTORNEY FEES.

- 15 It shall be unlawful for an amount exceeding 10 per-
- 16 cent of the amount paid pursuant to section 1 to be paid
- 17 to, or received by, any agent or attorney for any service
- 18 rendered in connection with the claim described in such
- 19 section. Any person who violates this section shall be
- 20 guilty of an infraction, and shall be subject to a fine in
- 21 the amount provided in title 18, United States Code.
