A BILL

To provide for the ratification of payments made under preexisting onshore and offshore royalty-in-kind programs.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. RATIFICATION OF PAYMENTS.
- 4 Amounts invoiced by the Secretary of the Interior
- 5 and paid in full before the date of enactment of this Act
- 6 for the purchase of Federal royalty oil by a refiner pursu-
- 7 ant to section 36 of the Mineral Leasing Act (30 U.S.C.
- 8 192) or section 27 of the Outer Continental Shelf Lands
- 9 Act (43 U.S.C. 1353) are hereby ratified and deemed to
- 10 be the purchaser's total obligation to the United States

- 1 for such purchases notwithstanding any other provision of
- 2 law, including the regulations set forth in 30 C.F.R.
- 3 208.13(b), subject to adjustment to reconcile billed vol-
- 4 umes with delivered volumes provided that all purchased
- 5 royalty oil volumes were processed or used, or exchanged
- 6 for other crude oil on a volume or equivalent basis that
- 7 was processed or used, in the refiner's refineries located
- 8 in the United States.
