To suspend until January 1, 2002, the duty on Sodium
Bentazon.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON SODIUM BENTAZON.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.32.60	Sodium Bentazon, (3-(1-methylethyl)-1H- 2,1, 3-benzothiadiazin- 4(3H)-one 2,2-di- oxide (provided for in subheading 2934.90.11)	5.0%	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2001	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 this section applies with respect to goods entered, or with-
3 drawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after the
4 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
