A BILL

For the relief of Kerantha Poole-Christian.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. IMMEDIATE RELATIVE STATUS FOR KERANTHA
- 4 POOLE-CHRISTIAN.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Kerantha Poole-Christian shall be
- 6 classified as a child under section 101(b)(1)(E) of the Im-
- 7 migration and Nationality Act for purposes of approval
- 8 of a relative visa petition filed under section 204 of such
- 9 Act by her adoptive parent and the filing of an application
- 10 for an immigrant visa or adjustment of status.
- 11 (b) Adjustment of Status.—If Kerantha Poole-
- 12 Christian enters the United States before the filing dead-

- 1 line specified in subsection (c), she shall be considered to
- 2 have entered and remained lawfully and shall, if otherwise
- 3 eligible, be eligible for adjustment of status under section
- 4 245 of the Immigration and Nationality Act as of the date
- 5 of the enactment of this Act.
- 6 (c) Deadline for Application and Payment of
- 7 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the pe-
- 8 tition and the application for issuance of an immigrant
- 9 visa or the application for adjustment of status are filed
- 10 with appropriate fees within 2 years after the date of the
- 11 enactment of this Act.
- 12 (d) Reduction of Immigrant Visa Number.—
- 13 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-
- 14 idence to Kerantha Poole-Christian, the Secretary of State
- 15 shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 1, for the
- 16 current or next following fiscal year, the worldwide level
- 17 of family-sponsored immigrants under section
- 18 201(c)(1)(A) of the Immigration and Nationality Act.
- 19 (e) Denial of Preferential Immigration
- 20 Treatment for Certain Relatives.—The natural
- 21 parents, brothers, and sisters of Kerantha Poole-Christian
- 22 shall not, by virtue of such relationship, be accorded any
- 23 right, privilege, or status under the Immigration and
- 24 Nationality Act.
