A BILL

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. ELIMINATION OF NATIONALITY REQUIREMENT

FOR ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS OF SPOUSES

AND CHILDREN.

Section 202(d) of the Nicaraguan Adjustment and

Central American Relief Act is amended—

1	(1) in paragraph (1) by striking subparagraph
2	(A);
3	(2) by redesignating subparagraphs (B), (C),
4	(D), and (E) of paragraph (1) as subparagraphs
5	(A), (B), (C), and (D), respectively;
6	(3) in paragraph (2) by striking "paragraph
7	(1)(B)," and inserting "paragraph (1)(A)".
