3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Anti-FCC Phone Tax
5 Act of 1998”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEALS.**

7 The following provisions of section 254 of the Com-
8 munications Act of 1934 (47 U.S.C. 254) are repealed:

- 1 (1) Paragraph (6) of subsection (b).
- 2 (2) Subsection (h).
