- 6 be known and designated as the "J.I. Washington, III,
- 7 Post Office", and any reference in a law, map, regulation,
- 8 document, paper, or other record of the United States to

- 1 such building shall be deemed to be a reference to the
- 2 "J.I. Washington, III, Post Office".
