- 3 SECTION 1. TREATMENT OF UNWROUGHT TITANIUM FOR
- 4 GENERALIZED SYSTEM OF PREFERENCES.
- 5 (a) Section 503(b)(1) of the Trade Act of 1974, as
- 6 amended (19 U.S.C. 2463) is amended by inserting after
- 7 subparagraph (D) the following new subparagraph:
- 8 "(E) unwrought titanium products speci-
- 9 fied in subheading 8108.10.50 of the Har-

- 1 monized Tariff Schedules of the United
- 2 States."
- 3 (b) By redesignating subparagraphs (E), (F), and
- 4 (G), as subparagraphs (F), (G) and (H), respectively.
- 5 SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 6 The amendments made by section 1 shall apply with
- 7 respect to articles entered or withdrawn from warehouse
- 8 for consumption after the date of enactment of this Act.
