A BILL

To provide for equitable retirement for military reserve technicians who are covered under the Federal Employment Retirement System or the Civil Service Retirement System.

- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. EQUITABLE RETIREMENT FOR MILITARY RE-
- 4 SERVE TECHNICIANS.
- 5 (a) Technicians Covered by CSRS.—Section
- 6 8336 of title 5, United States Code, is amended by adding
- 7 at the end the following new subsection:

"(o) A military reserve technician (as that term is 1 2 defined in section 8401(30) of this title), is entitled to an 3 annuity if such technician— "(1) is separated from service as a military re-4 5 serve technician after becoming 50 years of age and completing 20 years of such service; or 6 "(2) is separated from service as a military re-7 8 serve technician after completing 25 years of such 9 service.". 10 (b) TECHNICIANS COVERED BY FERS.—Section 8414(c) of such title is amended— 11 (1) by inserting "(1)" after "(c)"; and 12 13 (2) by adding at the end the following new 14 paragraph: "(2) A military reserve technician is entitled to an 15 annuity if such technician— 16 "(1) is separated from service as a military re-17 18 serve technician after becoming 50 years of age and 19 completing 20 years of such service; or "(2) is separated from service as a military re-20 21 serve technician after completing 25 years of such 22 service.". 23 (c) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by this section shall apply with respect to a separation from service as a military reserve technician (as that term is defined

- 1 in section 8401(30) of title 5, United States Code) occur-
- 2 ring on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
