## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Transportation to conduct a study and transmit a report to Congress on improving the safety of persons present at roadside emergency scenes and to encourage States to enact and enforce laws based upon that report.

- 3 SECTION 1. STUDY ON SAFETY AT ROADSIDE EMERGENCY
- 4 SCENES.
- 5 (a) STUDY.—The Secretary of Transportation shall
- 6 conduct a study to evaluate options for improving the safe-

ty of persons present at roadside emergency scenes, including motor vehicle accident scenes. 3 (b) Laws and Options To Be Evaluated.—In conducting the study under this Act, the Secretary shall 5 evaluate— 6 (1) the effectiveness of State laws aimed at im-7 proving the safety of persons present at roadside 8 emergency scenes; 9 (2) the feasibility of requiring a person operat-10 ing a motor vehicle that is approaching a roadside 11 emergency scene to— 12 (A) move to the furthest traffic lane from 13 the roadside emergency scene available for traf-14 fic that is moving in the direction the person is 15 traveling; and 16 (B) decrease motor vehicular speed to 10 17 miles per hour less than the posted speed limit; 18 and 19 (3) other options for improving the safety of 20 persons present at roadside emergency scenes. 21 (c) Report.—Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall transmit to

Congress a report on the results of the study conducted

pursuant to subsection (a), together with any rec-

ommendations for improving the safety of persons present

- 5 enact and enforce laws to improve the safety of persons

- 8 tions contained in the report required by section 1(c) thus
- 9 making it unnecessary for Congress to enact Federal legis-
- 10 lation to withhold Federal highway funds until such State
- 11 laws are enacted and enforced.
