To provide for full voting representation in the Congress for the District of Columbia.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "District of Columbia
- 5 Voting Rights Act of 1998".
- 6 SEC. 2. REPRESENTATION IN CONGRESS FOR DISTRICT OF
- 7 COLUMBIA.
- 8 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the com-
- 9 munity of American citizens who are residents of the Dis-
- 10 trict constituting the seat of government of the United

- 1 States shall have full voting representation in the Con-
- 2 gress.
- 3 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 4 This Act shall apply with respect to each Congress
- 5 beginning on or after the date of the enactment of this
- 6 Act.
