## A BILL

To require the Secretary of Energy to submit to Congress a plan to ensure that all amounts accrued on the books of the United States Enrichment Corporation for the disposition of depleted uranium hexafluoride will be used to treat and recycle depleted uranium hexafluoride.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. UNITED STATES ENRICHMENT CORPORATION.**

4       (a) PLAN.—The Secretary of Energy shall prepare,  
5       and the President shall include in the budget request for  
6       fiscal year 2000, a plan and proposed legislation to ensure

1 that all amounts accrued on the books of the United  
2 States Enrichment Corporation for the disposition of de-  
3 pleted uranium hexafluoride will be used to commence con-  
4 struction of, not later than January 31, 2004, and to oper-  
5 ate, an onsite facility at each of the gaseous diffusion  
6 plants at Paducah, Kentucky, and Portsmouth, Ohio, to  
7 treat and recycle depleted uranium hexafluoride.

8 (b) LIMITATION.—Notwithstanding privatization or  
9 any other provision of law, including section 3116 of the  
10 United States Enrichment Corporation Privatization Act,  
11 no amounts described in subsection (a) shall be withdrawn  
12 from the United States Enrichment Corporation Fund es-  
13 tablished by section 1308 of the Atomic Energy Act of  
14 1954 (42 U.S.C. 2297b–7) or the Working Capital Ac-  
15 count established under section 1316 of the Atomic En-  
16 ergy Act of 1954 (42 U.S.C. 2297b–15) and shall remain  
17 in effect until the date that is 1 year after the date on  
18 which the President submits to Congress the budget re-  
19 quest for fiscal year 2000.
