SECTION 1. CHILD CARE SERVICES FOR FEDERAL EMPLOY-

- 3 (a) In General.—An Executive agency which pro-
- 4 vides or proposes to provide child care services for Federal
- 5 employees may use appropriated funds (otherwise avail-
- 6 able to such agency for salaries) to provide child care, in
- 7 a Federal or leased facility, or through contract, for civil-
- 8 ian employees of such agency.
- 9 (b) Affordability.—Amounts so provided with re-
- 10 spect to any such facility or contractor shall be applied
- 11 to improve the affordability of child care for lower income
- 12 Federal employees using or seeking to use the child care
- 13 services offered by such facility or contractor.
- 14 (c) Regulations.—The Office of Personnel Man-
- 15 agement shall, within 180 days after the date of enact-
- 16 ment of this Act, issue regulations necessary to carry out
- 17 this section.
- 18 (d) Definition.—For purposes of this section, the
- 19 term "Executive agency" has the meaning given such term

- 1 by section 105 of title 5, United States Code, but does
- $2\,\,$ not include the General Accounting Office.
