- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "United States Statue
- 5 of Liberty \$1 Coin Act of 1998".
- 6 SEC. 2. STATUE OF LIBERTY \$1 COIN.
- 7 (a) In General.—Section 5112(d)(1) of title 31,
- 8 United States Code (as amended by section 4(d) of Public
- 9 Law 105-124) is amended by inserting after the 4th sen-
- 10 tence the following new sentence: "The obverse side of the

- 1 dollar coin shall have a design depicting the Statue of Lib-2 erty.".
 - (b) Technical and Conforming Amendments.—
- (1) The 6th sentence of section 5112(d)(1) of title 31, United States Code (as amended by subsection (a) of this section) is amended by striking "appropriate designs for the obverse and the reverse sides" and inserting "an appropriate design for the reverse side".
 - (2) Section 4(e)(1) of Public Law 105–124 is amended by striking ", as amended by this section".
